HOW TO QUALIFY FOR YOUR SOLO PROFICIENCY RATING AT JOMAC

The Novice Pilot wants to do nothing more than to fly on their own, but to do this, you need to have a SAMAA, Solo Proficiency Rating. JOMAC can help you to achieve this goal, if you follow a few simple steps.

- Contact one or more of the accredited JOMAC Instructors to find out who is available to assist you.
- Introduce yourself and your aircraft to the Instructor, and make an arrangement for a series of flight lessons.
- Not only will the Instructor teach you how to fly, he will also prepare you for your SAMAA, Solo Proficiency Flight.
- The flight manoeuvres for Solo Proficiency, are contained in the Proficiency Booklet, which you must download from the SAMAA Website (you can find a link to SAMAA on our website).
- When the Instructor believes you are competent, you must contact two of the SAMAA rated Judges and make an arrangement for your Solo Proficiency Flight.
- On the day of the flight, you must have two copies of the Solo Proficiency Test Page available, for the Judges to complete.
- On passing the Flight Test, the Pages are given to the JOMAC Committee for submission to SAMAA, who will award your SAMAA, Solo Proficiency rating.
